Impact of Coach Training: Multiplication Already Happening

We are now four months into CMI's 24-month professional level Mission Coach Training. One of the RM Coach Trainees is a recently returned missionary from a closed country. He and his wife worked extensively in planting churches among Muslim-background believers. As part of his coach training he has been coaching one of the national church leaders they were working with, and doing so in the national language. Here's a recent report:

"My coaching times with H have been excellent. H and his wife already have a leadership role and have been trained in marriage counseling/church planting/inner healing ministry and are leaders, counselors and mentors for at least 60 other underground church pastors and leaders. What I was the most excited about was how during our coaching time, H would often pause for a long time and then say... "That's a great question, I'm taking time to write it down so that I can ask that to other people." He immediately created his own peer group where they are asking each other many of the questions that I coach H with."

Other Trainees are also coaching in national languages, such as Arabic, Portuguese and more. This is the kind of multiplication of cross-cultural coaching into the frontlines that we had hoped to see through this training, and it's already happening. Thank you for your continued prayer and support that help make it possible!
